HRING OF K9 NARCOTICS DETECTION SERVICE PACKAGE (LOTS 1 & 2)
BAC Resolution No. **2020-043**

Whereas, the Manila International Airport Authority needs to engage the services of a private K-9 Security Specialist that could pursue its anti-narcotics mission and the task of Anti-Drug Traffic at the NAIA Terminals;

Whereas, rental of K9 provider has been determined to be more feasible and viable than the procurement and training of new K9 NDD teams;

Whereas, the Project is divided into two (2) lots and with an Approved Budget for the Contract in the amount as follows:

Whereas, the Bids and Awards Committee invited interested contractors to apply for eligibility and to bid through an Invitation to Bid which was posted in the, MIAA Website and conspicuous bulletin boards from September 11 to October 16, 2020;

Whereas, five (5) prospective bidders purchased the Bid Documents and attended the Pre-bid Conference on September 23, 2020, namely;

1. Land and rail K9 Security Services
2. Lockheed Global Security and Investigation Services, Inc.
3. JV of Sniffer K9 and DSL K9
4. Search and Secure Canine Training and Services Int'l. Inc.
5. Zemog K9 Training Center, Inc.

Whereas, the above prospective bidders submitted their Eligibility, Technical and Financial Proposals during the submission and opening of bids on October 16, 2020. The results are as follows;

The contract shall be for a period of one (1) year, renewable yearly for a maximum period of three (3) years at the option of the Authority, to commence on the date to be stated in the Notice to Proceed.
